Project Description:

The Department has conducted a full technical review, prepared a draft permit and made a tentative determination, subject to public comments or other information, to approve a reauthorization and modification of a lapsed SPDES permit for an existing discharge of 0.1475 million gallons per day of treated sanitary wastewater to the Walkill River, a Class B waterbody, from a tertiary treatment plant at 470 State Route in the Town of Montgomery, Orange County. The facility is a publicly owned treatment works that receives flow from domestic and industrial users.

Modifications to the permit include the following:

- Modified limits for Total Residual Chlorine
- Added effluent limits for Total Phosphorus and Ammonia
- Added monitoring requirement for Dissolved Oxygen, Total Dissolved Solids, and emerging contaminants
- Added a Mercury Minimization Program and a Mini Industrial Pretreatment Program
- Removed approval for the 0.25 million gallons per day (MGD) plant expansion as it is no longer proposed.
